The Foundation will launch this program in Title 1 schools and community centers to provide economically-challenged elementary and high school students with books and technology tools. Phase I will encourage K-5 students to embrace personal reading and literacy improvement. Phase II will encourage middle and high school students to increase their technology skills for career opportunities.
